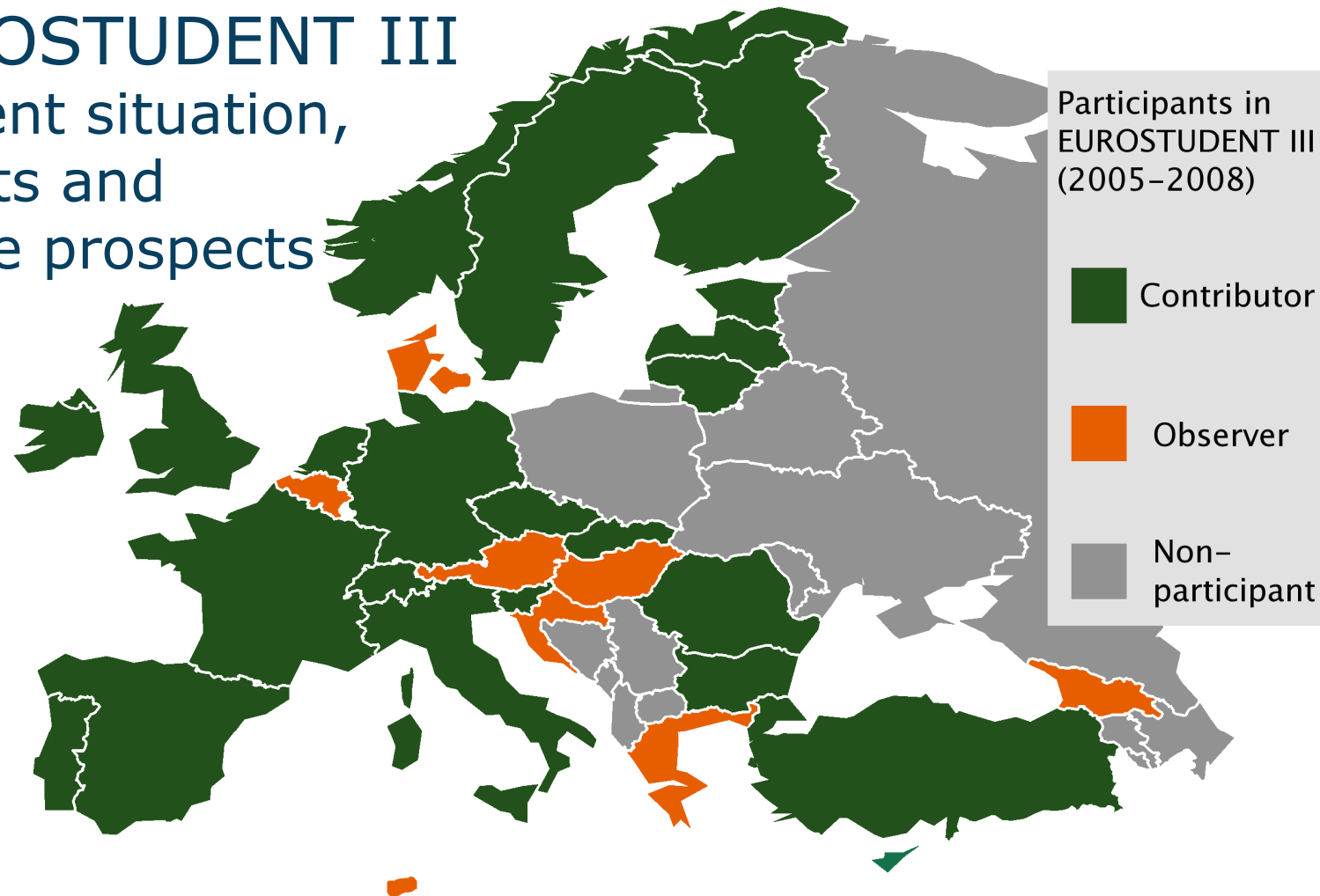

  - To provide a structured and standardised monitoring system with which the effects of structural measures and changes can be identified for specific student groups

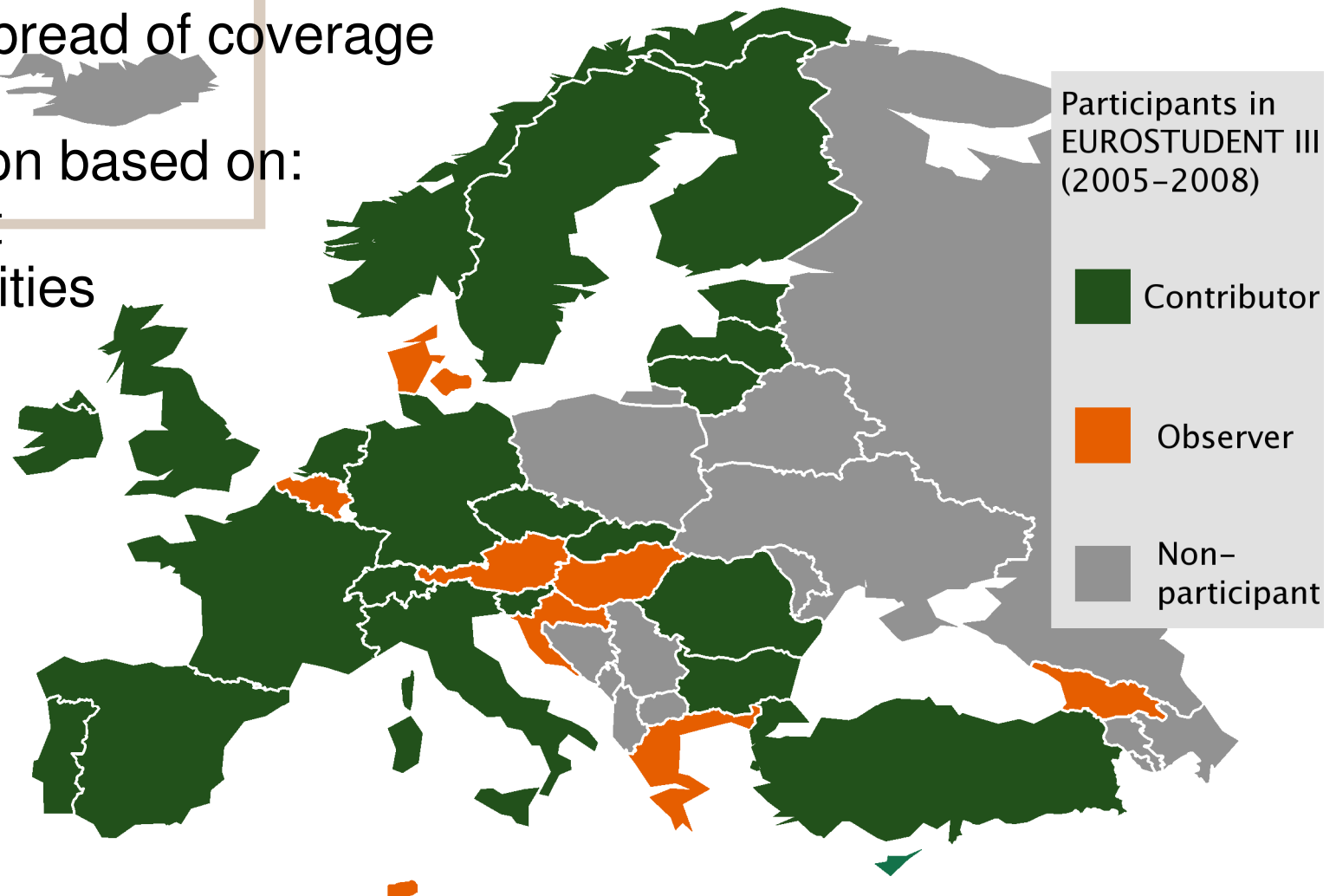

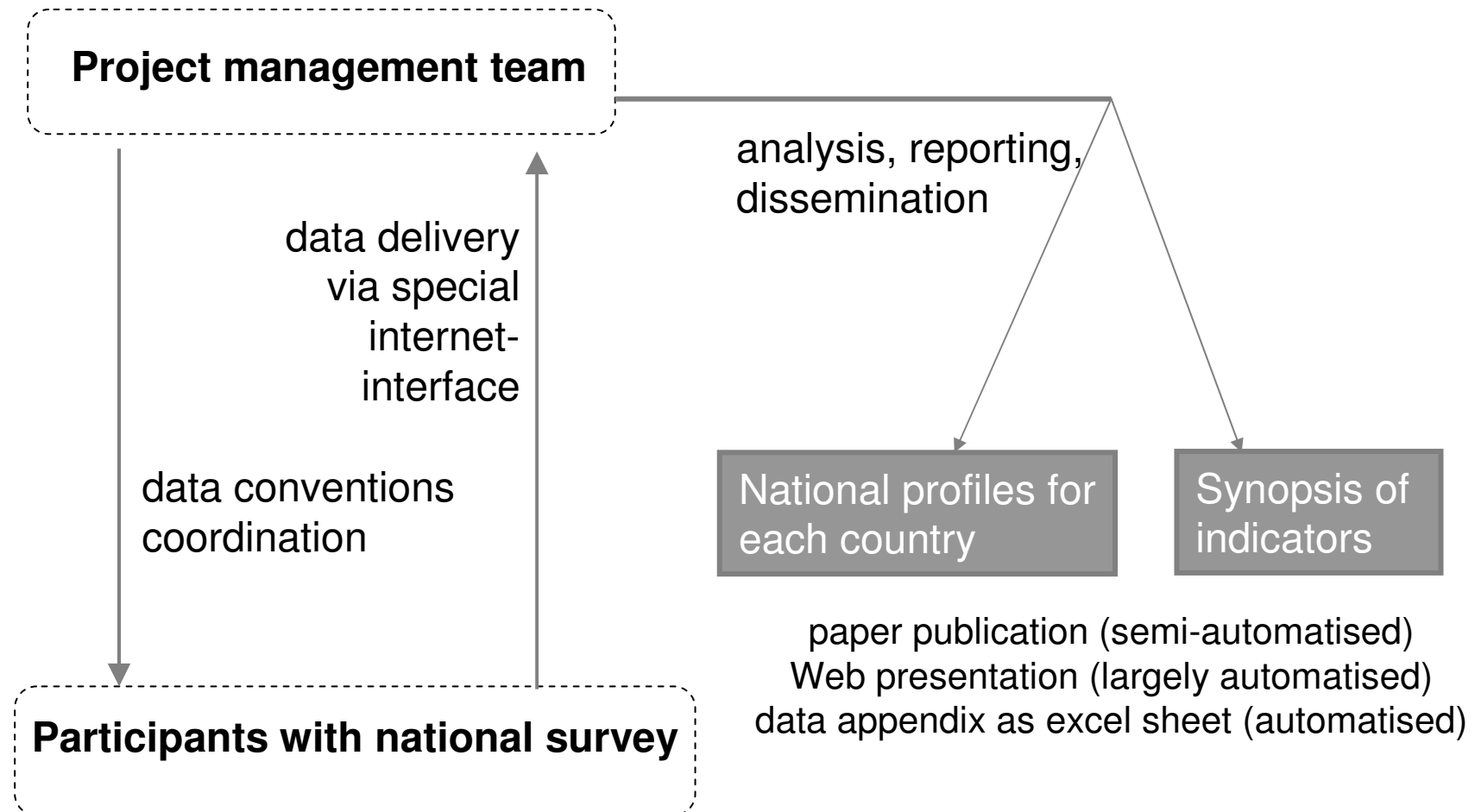
