Categories


- [News](#) – all about politics, agencies, universities and new studies and publications
- [Calendar of events](#)
- [Institutions](#) – lists all agencies and associations
- [Procedures](#)
- [Opinion](#)
- [Literature pool](#) – contains relevant literature which is subdivided into categories
- [Link pool](#) – collects links of interest

What is evanet?

Newsletter

- is distributed as a PDF and is sent out every six weeks
- content from specific categories of the site and extra research and external articles from agencies

What is evanet? - Newsletter




What is evaNet? - Newsletter

- Newsletter pdf is put on our server
- A link to pdf is sent out via E-mail to subscribers


Who uses „evaNet“?

What is the technical background of “evanet”?

- Self-developed CMS (Content Management System)
- Combines PHP as scripting language and MySQL as database
- Both are open source
- Mix between dynamic (data based) and static (HTML-based) content.

What is the technical background of “evanet”?

Capabilities of the CMS

- Modular
- Extension and variation is always possible
- CMS-user-interface is online, which means
 - items can be edited and put online on any computer with internet-connection
 - no need for editors to know HTML or any script-language
 - editors are mostly independent of technicians in doing their work
 - news are online the minute they are written

How did evaNet evolve?

1998

German Rectors' Conference (HRK/Projekt Q) and Ministry of Education saw the need for a system that

- reports
- documents
- crosslinks

all evaluation activities in Germany

How did evaNet evolve?


1998

- evaNet relied heavily on user input
- many interactive features
- input-oriented

How did evaNet evolve?

Focus changed from:

1998: “interactive pinboard”



2004: News- and Information Platform, gathering and collecting data

How did „evaNet“ evolve?

2004

- evanet relies heavily on edited input
- collects and structures data
- output-oriented

How will evaNet develop?

- Web 2.0 →
 - shift focus to users again (community)
 - WAP (evaNet-news for mobile phones)
 - RSS-feeds
 - Chats with experts
 - Discussion forums

Input versus output?

Pro “Input”-orientation

- Site gets updates on short intervals
- Users participate
- Possibility of “real-time”-networking

Con “Input”-orientation

- heavy workload in editing and huge costs for maintenance
- without user input there`s not much content
- data tends to get fragmented all over the page

Input versus output?

Pro “Output”-orientation

- Data gets structured by editors
- Less workload for editors and less manpower needed
- Better control over content

Con “Output”-orientation

- More time between updates
- Less user-participation
